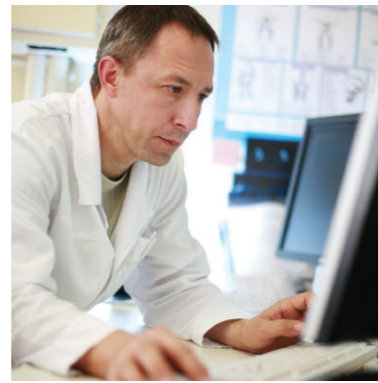

Compucare, a comprehensive management system designed specifically for the Independent hospital, clinic and NHS private patient unit.

Features of the latest version are:

A popular choice with staff

Compucare is a familiar looking Windows based system, easily managed by all members of staff with full integration provided with Microsoft Word and Excel. Compucare fulfils the demands of both the smaller clinic and the larger hospital with hundreds of users. It can be deployed over a local or wide area network.

The system is modular and can be configured to meet most needs of the modern private hospital from the handling of the initial referral through to discharge and billing. The patient pathway can be fully recorded and a full electronic patient record maintained. Patient data, tests, notes and outcomes can be directly recorded or can be recorded directly from a large number of other supporting systems, such as PACS, using numerous supported interfaces. A patient notepad also maintains a full record of all notes on a patient's progress.

Apart from specific modules, there are core features which support standard correspondence, forms, e-mail, SMS text messages and report generation.

The E-bookings module allows Consultants to be given remote access over the internet to make bookings or view their own clinics. It can also be configured to accept private referrals directly from GPs. Access controls allow the hospital to determine exactly what each user is able to perform.

NHS Reporting and Referrals

Compucare is an approved PAS for linking to Connecting for Health's Choose and Book system. Compucare allows you to selectively publish outpatient appointments to GPs and referrers so that NHS referrals can be directly received into Compucare.

Compucare fully supports the 18 week wait and can warn users which patients are close to or have passed their breach dates. Compucare can also produce the data extract for submissions to the Secondary Use Service (SUS). Unify reporting is also provided, with drill down reports so that the data can be interrogated prior to reporting to the Department of Health.

Integration with 3rd Parties

MessageCall 2 is our new integration engine which is used to link Compucare to third party systems. It supports industry standard messages such as HL7 or can be configured to recognise other proprietary formats. MessageCall 2 also supports a number of different protocols for sending and receiving these messages, including SOAP, TCP/IP, HTTP/S, File transfer, Microsoft Message Queues and ebXml.

Examples of interfaces that Message Call 2 is used for are:

- ADT/Demographic messages either to 3rd party system or from NHS PAS's.
- Bidirectional interfaces with PACS/RIS
- Import of activity from a 3rd party system which is then mapped to a charge and allocated to a patient invoice.
- Appointment messages



A Managers wish list

Managers can maintain current information on activity and costs. As higher standards of independent care are expected, Compucare will help managers meet those standards providing an accurate and up to date picture of hospital activity and profitability.

Contract management simplifies complex arrangements with insurers and purchasers and allows the benefits of contractual agreements to be easily assessed.

The Compucare report generator supports ad-hoc analysis of performance allowing managers access to information in text and graphical format. Reports can also be scheduled and run automatically and, where appropriate, exported directly to Excel.

The Compucare EDI module enables invoices and remittances to be handled electronically which reduces paperwork and greatly improves cash flow.

Compucare can be provided with its own comprehensive multi- currency financial package or can be linked to most Windows based accounting systems. The Compucare financial package includes a Fixed Asset Register which also incorporates all maintenance schedules for sensitive equipment.

The patient - A Secure Environment

In healthcare, security of patient information is vital. Compucare allows functionality and reports to be customised for each user and additional controls can be implemented on individual workstations in sensitive areas. Compucare complies with NHS security standards. Additional features include: the definition of password length between defined minima and maxima, the setting of password expiry, the maintenance of password history and a banned word list.
